The mission was led by the Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO), aimed at strengthering India's overall security. The LEO satellite was orbiting at an altitude of 300 km, P.M. Modi said. The Prime Minister also said that India's action was not directed against any country and no international laws or treaties were breached. The mission was a hightly complex one and was conducted at extremely high speed with remarkable precision, P.M. Modi said.
